Introduction, page xx:

The duet no. 2 in the *Einführungsmusik Winkler* was not newly composed by Bach. The *Vorlage* has been identified as the duet “Traue du auf sein Versprechen” from the cantata *Herr, leite mich* by Johann Gottlieb Graun (GraunWV Av:IX:3, arranged by Bach as BR-CPEB F 4; see CPEB:CW, V/2.7).

This set of MS parts from Bach’s library contains Bach’s arrangement of the cantata *Herr, leite mich*, GraunWV Av:IX:3, as BR-CPEB F 4. This source was probably used as the *Vorlage* for the duet no. 2 in the *Einführungsmusik Winkler*, H 821f. For a full description of this source, see CPEB:CW, V/2.7.

Critical Report, page 162, left column, under 2. *Duett*, add:

This duet was borrowed from J.G. Graun’s cantata *Herr, leite mich*, GraunWV Av:IX:3 (arranged by Bach as BR-CPEB F 4). Bach made significant revisions to his model (cf. CPEB:CW, V/2.7).
